ABOUT AVES THEATRE

Sycamore High School's comprehensive theatre program stages three main stage productions, an improvisational comedy show, a one-act play festival in December, a student-directed one-act festival in April, and a 30-minute Shakespeare performance each school year.

Sycamore High School offers five curricular classes including Technical Theatre, Technical Theatre In-Depth, Acting Technique, Theatre Appreciation, and two sections of Acting Ensemble. Acting Ensemble is an upperclassmen course that is open by audition only. Many of our productions are co-curricular projects of our theatre courses. Our Spring musical and Improv show are completely extra-curricular productions and auditions for those productions are open to all Sycamore High School students each year.

Students in Aves Theatre are involved in all aspects of our theatre productions. Set construction, painting, stage lighting, sound, theatrical costumes, and props are all put together with heavy student involvement. We believe in educating young people as students of the overall theatre art form and, as such, performers contribute heavily in technical areas. Many students who fill technical roles in this production will be performers in productions later this year, and many of the performers you see in this show will work as technicians on future productions.

In addition to Aves Theatre's many school year productions, Aves Theatre offers a regional high school summer theatre program open to high school students throughout the greater Cincinnati area.

Funds raised during this event, together with grants, have enabled the purchase of equipment for the Aves Theatre Boosters Cutting-EDGE project

What is the Cutting- EDGE Project:

This project provides modern innovative theatre set design tools and training, combining art and technology for Sycamore High School's Aves Theatre.

Funding a mix of equipment and educator and student training, the Cutting-EDGE Project expands hands-on student learning of technologies shaping the future of design. By using modern tools and systems, students learn to work on set diagramming and construction with industry-standard technology, preparing them for careers in technical theatre, design and beyond.

At the center of this project is the purchase of a CNC Router. This state-of-the-art digitally controlled precision cutting tool gives students freedom to implement creative designs and accelerate the process of set construction through teamwork, intricate design, and precision cutting.

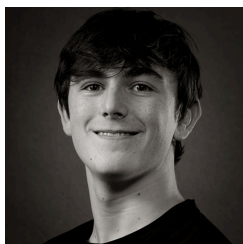
